Graduation Requirements

EDHP students must complete 34 hours, and no grades lower than a B may be applied to the degree. Students must score an 80 or higher to successfully pass a course. Any transfer courses will need approval prior to applying them to a degree plan. A degree must be completed in 7 years and a thesis student must complete all thesis requirements per [Thesis and Dissertation Services](#).

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Course Requirements

¹This can be taken as 1 credit hour each; 2 hours total must be completed. Completing a teaching practicum in a clinical setting may require a background check and drug test based on the requirements of the clinic. The student will be financially responsible for these fees.

² Per TAMU guidelines, students must fulfill at least 1 credit hour of this course; no more than 3 credit hours can be applied to your degree plan. Research 691 may be used for continuous enrollment while applying for graduation. Students may **not apply more than 3 credit hours of 691 to their degree**. This course may only be taken twice.
